The Associate Youth and College Minister reports directly to the Minister of Youth and College.

Responsibilities

- Primary responsibilities are to be focused on the pastoral care, spiritual development and wellness of ages 6th grade through college, building relationships and actively engaging in their lives.
- Partner with the Minister of Youth and College in yearly theme development and calendaring.
- Assist in leading Bible Studies, Devotions, and other faith development activities.
- Attend all youth ministry activities, events, and regularly scheduled Wednesday and Sunday evenings.
- Organize and lead the Sunday school teaching team; schedules, curriculum, communication.
- Plan and lead recreational times for youth, such as game nights, day trips, and overnight trips designed for fellowship.
- Assist with planning and leading spiritual development camps, retreats and trips as a chaperone, group leader, recreation leader, driver, etc.
- Plan and carry out local and regional mission projects.
- Lead the congregational college ministry, including coordinating social gatherings, lessons, and missions experiences.
- Participate in worship regularly.
- Assist in developing Youth Missions and Ministry yearly budget.
- Assist with the operation of the Youth Ministry office as needed.
- Assist the Minister of Youth and College with the committees for which they serve as staff liaison.
- Attend Worship Planning, Coordination Team, Care and Concern, and General Staff meetings.
- Manage publicity for youth events and activities.
- Attend continuing education opportunities as scheduling and finances allow.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Minister of Youth and College.
