

Associate Pastor of Youth/College

Summary of Position

The Associate Pastor of Youth and College will primarily lead the church's ministry to students in grades 6 - College to shape lifelong disciples of Jesus Christ.

Qualifications and Requirements

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited university required, with preference given to a Master's in Divinity or Biblical Studies graduate work.
- At least 3 years of experience working with students aged 11-College.
- Experience with and/or willingness to preach in Sunday morning worship as called upon.
- Good organizational and leadership skills.
- Strong verbal, visual, and written communication skills.
- Ordination is not required but recommended.

Characteristics

- A deep and personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
- A healthy personal practice of prayer, Bible study, and overall discipleship.
- A clear calling to care for all.
- An inclusive disposition that takes note of people, regardless of their race, gender, economic status, or marginalization to minister to them and include them in the CBCFC ministry.
- An ability to work well with a team to achieve overall goals while looking for ways to involve everyone in our ministries.

Responsibilities

- Develop and implement an effective ministry to middle school and high school students, by providing weekly discipleship and fellowship opportunities, regular events, retreats.
- Develop and implement an effective ministry to college age adults by providing regular fellowship and discipleship opportunities or activities.
- Develop student leaders and provide ways for students to volunteer in the community and participate in the life of the church and its leadership.
- Recruit, develop, and deploy volunteers for the church's youth and college ministry, encouraging a network of caring adults who contribute to our students' discipleship.
- Serve as the primary point of pastoral care for students and their families, including attendance and support of extracurricular activities in the community whenever possible.
- Work with and support other missions and ministries of CBCFC.
